About the Race

The Mission to Seafarers created the Maritime Mountain Race as a unique fundraising challenge set in the stunning Swiss landscape. With 30 teams taking part, funds raised will enable the expansion of their vital frontline welfare services across Europe, the UAE and globally.

Seafarers often work in dangerous, isolated environments, experiencing mental and physical health issues, the risk of abandonment, and the increasing threat of piracy. MtS have designed this race to offer a way for the international shipping community to support the seafarers who keep our global economy afloat. They hope to increase awareness and funds for their work as an international maritime charity and one of the largest providers of seafarer welfare support worldwide.

The work of The Mission to Seafarers

Over 90% of world trade is carried by sea, providing work to 1.89 million seafarers. Shipping is a truly international industry: in today's global market, you might have a Greek-owned vessel, registered in Malta, with officers from India and a crew from Thailand, Indonesia, Vanuatu, and the Philippines.

Shipping provides people with many opportunities: to see the world and to work in a job where you know you're making a difference. However, it is also one of the world's most dangerous occupations, with piracy, shipwrecks, and abandonment just some of the threats seafarers face. Seafarers endure isolation, long periods of separation from their families, and significant communication challenges. Mental health issues are prevalent, but MtS volunteers and chaplains are there to provide support, whether that's online, on board or at our Seafarers Centres. The Mission to Seafarers offers human connection, compassion and gratitude for the work our seafarers do, and provides practical help when they need it most.
